FUNDING FOR CONTEMPORARY ART PROJECTS

GUIDELINES

- APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTED BY MAY 1ST, 2012
- All applications must be prepared in English.
- Projects must not begin before JULY, 2012.
- Projects must be send by mail only.
- Results will be announced in June 2012.

- Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered under any circumstances.
- The Fund cannot be held responsible for any damage (to) or loss of documents or materials submitted. Materials will be returned provided that a self-addressed stamped envelope is included.

STEP 1

PREPARE THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS

- Application Form "Project Grant"
- Budget (See Budget Details)
- Project Description
- Copy of 501(c)3 form
- Organization History, Artist Bios, Curator Bios
- A CD-Rom/DVD with video extracts and/or a maximum of 20 images (please provide a list of the images).

THE BUDGET DETAILS (IN US DOLLARS)

Attach a complete overall project budget (in USD) with detailed expenses related to the presentation of the French artists.
